Contributions and Charges Information

Voluntary Contributions for Years 7 to 10

All schools are required to make sure that all students can choose an education program that satisfies the requirements of the Curriculum Framework. The maximum voluntary contribution that can be requested is \$235.00. If the Secondary Assistance Scheme is claimed under Government Policy it is used to reduce voluntary contributions.

Policy states: \$235.00 Education Program Allowance is paid directly to the school. For students in Years 7-10 the allowance will be applied to the voluntary contributions in the first instance and any balance will be applied to compulsory charges. For students in Years 11 and 12 the Allowance will be applied to compulsory charges in the first instance. This amount reduces the voluntary contributions requested of the parent/guardian in Years 7-10.

Compulsory Charges for Years 7 to 10

These contributions cover essential items that cannot be withdrawn for non-payment. All schools are required to make sure that all students can choose an education program that satisfies the requirements of the Curriculum Framework.

Compulsory Charges for Years 11 to 12

These cover all courses. For Year 11 and 12 all activities are treated as optional components under the government's Contributions and Charges Policy. There is no established maximum for costs in Years 11 and 12. In addition there are Optional Costs listed under Extra Cost Options, which are listed in the Contributions and Charges Information Booklet.

Secondary Assistance Scheme Application

Deadline: The last day of Term 1 (8 April 2022)

The WA Department of Education provides an allowance to assist eligible families with secondary schooling costs. Parents/Guardians who hold one of the following cards are eligible to apply for this assistance.

- Centrelink Family Health Care Card
- Centrelink Pensioner Concession Card
- Veteran's Affairs Pensioner Concession Card (Blue Card Only)

Note that students in receipt of ABSTUDY are eligible for the ABSTUDY supplement allowance.

Note: Cardholders cannot claim both Abstudy and SAS. Claim only one or the other.

Application forms are only available from Melville Senior High School and the school recommends that applications be completed as soon as possible. Schools must submit completed and witnessed application forms to the Schools Resourcing Branch in Central Office by 8 April 2022.

Melville Senior High School's School Board has ratified all voluntary contributions, charges and extra cost options and has approved a 50% confirmation charge for extra cost optional components.

Purchase of Personal Items

School Top	MSHS jacket - zipped, green, white and black with school logo or MSHS bottle green woollen jumper or MSHS leavers jacket - black and white with school logo (option for years 11 and 12)
Scarf (optional)	MSHS black or green with school logo
Physical Education	MSHS bottle green polo shirt with gold and white stripe (Not to be worn at other times) MSHS black sport shorts or tracksuit pants with MSHS logo
