

Preparing for your Interview at Melville Senior High School

- Be on time – your allocated interview time is scheduled and may result in your interview being shorter if you are late.
- Allow time to sign in and use hand sanitiser prior to your interview.
- Be well presented.
- Speak clearly and give eye contact to the interviewer.
- You are welcome to bring your parent or guardian into the interview with you - remember to address the interviewer not your parent when speaking.
- Be well prepared to answer questions about the course and the areas of interest for the course you are interviewing for. Think of any questions that you may wish to ask of the interviewer.
- Thank the teacher for the opportunity to be interviewed/trialled/auditioned.
